Renovators of South Kazakhstan Medical Academy were trained at seminar-training “Development and improvement of educational programmes in strategic management and health risk management” from 23.05.2022 to 27.05.2023 at the University of Western Attica, Athens, Greece. Academy renovators also participated in the development of the Master's (Fiche Metier) Job descriptions based on the key needs of the New Kazakhstan health care system.

Following the development of the Job descriptions, JSC SKMA re-innovators developed the Accreditation Dossier for the Master's degree program in in the profile direction “Public Health”. Updating of the Master's degree educational program in the profile direction 7M10102 “Public Health” (hereinafter referred to as EP) is carried out in accordance with the CEC (EQF) and the Bologna Process.



The working group on modernization of EP consists of renovators and leading specialists-teachers of the department “Social health insurance and public health” (SHI and PH). The process of updating the curriculum is supervised by Sarsenbaeva G.Zh., Head of the Department of SHI and PH, Candidate of Medical Sciences, Associate Professor.

Enrolment in the renewed programme is planned for the academic year 2023-2024.

The development and implementation of courses to improve the qualifications of health care organizers and medical examiners is carried out by Sadibekova Zh.U., associate professor and leading specialist of the Faculty for Continuing Professional Development (DCPD) of SHI and PH department.
