for high-quality sound accompaniment of filming processes and voiceover during the development of video lectures, video tutorials and MOOCs.

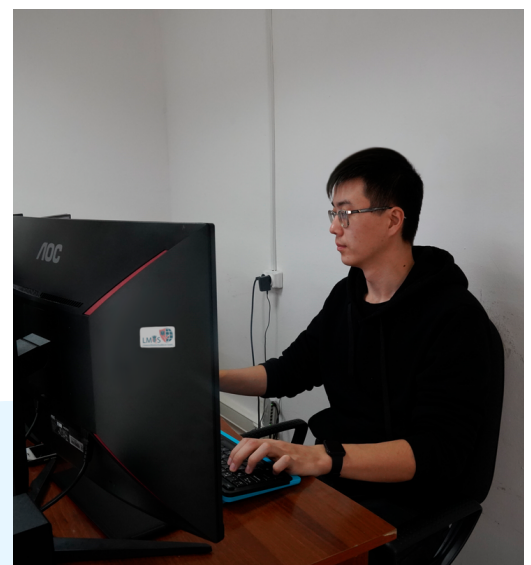


COMPUTER ASSEMBLY
